

- An athlete will only be permitted to undergo International Classification if he or she:
 - Is licensed with International Federations (IFs) for the 2025 Season
 - Has been entered into the competition by the classification entry deadline.



- Classification will take place in Cebeci Sports Complex. Classification results will be published in accordance with the rules of each international federation.
- IFs will schedule athletes with a New, Review or Review Fixed Date (RFD) status pursuant with the current rules and regulations.
- Please note that all athletes must comply with the following conditions before being accredited to the event: all athletes need to follow participation criteria as per sport.
- All athletes for the classification need to have a fully filled, dated and signed Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) and related documents as per Classification Rules relevant to the Sport.
- MDF forms need to be uploaded into the database that relevant sport is using (SDMS; ISAS; etc) with the relevant timeline per Classification rules.
- The MDF's will be thoroughly checked after they have been uploaded. Athletes without the correct MDF uploaded in due time will not be scheduled for classification and cannot enter the competition. There will be no exceptions.

Swimmers must:

- · be entered by their NPC or NF, with the NPC being a good standing member of IPC in EPYG portal and SDMS
- · be minimum 12 years old and the maximum is 18 years old by 31st December in the year of the competition.
- an athlete must have an International Classification status of Review (R), Fixed Review Date (FRD) or Have a classfication status Confirmed (C) to medal.
- · Any athlete on a New (N) Status not undergoing classification in the EPYG2025 may only swim in heats and will not progress to finals.
- · Only Athletes with Fixed Review Date (FRD) 2026 or later, or Confirmed (C) status are eligible for medals.
- NPCs must make all entries including those for classification through the World Para Swimming SDMS Entry System and comply with the above deadlines. If an NPC is requesting classification at EYPG for more than one athlete then you must submit a priority list of athletes to Franziska.Zenk@worldparaswimming.org by Wednesday 14 May 2025.



Classification:

Para Swimming classification will be ran under current World Para Swimming (WPS) Classification Rules and Regulations in 2022. International classification will happen international classification before the start of the competition. WPS will schedule an international classification for physically impaired (PI), visually impaired (VI) and intellectually impaired (II) athletes with new, review or FDR status 2025 or earlier. For VI athletes, IBSA will conduct centrally all VI classification processes during the games.




